## **ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21**

The academic year 2020-21 started with the reopening of school on 6<sup>th</sup> May 2020 for Std X and XII and 3rd June 2020 for all other classes. Due to the crisis created by the pandemic, classes were conducted online for LKG, UKG and Std I to XII. Assessment tests including Mid Term Exam, Term Exam and Final Exam for classes I to XI and Model Exam for Std X and XII were conducted online. The final Model Exam for classes X and XII was conducted in the school by following all the protocols of Covid 19.

Though classes were conducted online throughout the year, Extra- curricular and Co – curricular activities were given due importance. The school encouraged the students to use time efficiently, thus giving importance to protection of environment. Students were encouraged to take up activities like gardening, planting saplings and creating their own kitchen gardens. Poster competition on the topic 'Save Water' was conducted for students of classes I to X. Many of our students were engaged in activities related to SEED, an initiative taken by 'Mathrubhumi' Malayalam Daily. As part of Environment Day celebrations, the students planted saplings in their compound. Classes were conducted online on the importance of using bicycle as a means of transport so as to reduce fuel consumption and also for keeping the students fit and healthy. Ten of our students set up Bio Gas Plant at home and learned how to convert bio degradable waste into fuel and organic manure. Our students were also engaged in creating water pits at home to save rain water. The school won Haritha Keralam Vidyalaya Award [third prize] for the outstanding contribution for cause of environment protection and dedication in the SEED Project in the year 2020-21.

Sports, games and yoga practices were conducted online throughout the year. This helped in keeping our students healthy and hale at home. The Physical education classes conducted online were based on the topics of health education, physical education, first aid, nutrition and also about different types of games, their rules and the equipment used for these games along with a video presentation. Zumba and free hand practical and theory classes were given signifying the importance of these exercises in our daily life. In connection with National Sports Day, quiz and logo competitions were conducted for students. Our students participated in Stay Fit online quiz competition conducted by KOA and secured prizes too. Our school

assured maximum number of participation in 'Fit India Freedom Run' conducted by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. Our school team got a chance to participate in the district level Volleyball Tournament conducted by Kerala State Volleyball Association and the players received commendable appreciation. S. Sivadarshan of Std XII was selected for State Level Tournament.

Many Innovative activities to bring out the hidden talents of our students were conducted online during the academic session. The activities include activities like Patriotic Song and Dance, Recitation, Celebration of Reading month from June 19 to July 18, International Yoga Day activities, UN Day Against Drugs and Illicit Trafficking {June 26}, Doctor's Day { July I} when students wrote thank you note to health workers for expressing their gratitude to them, students created special video on Eid {31 July}, Independence Day celebrations {15 August}, Onam celebrations where students made floral carpet with fruits, seeds, nuts and flowers, Teachers Day celebration on September 4<sup>th</sup> when students as teachers took online classes, Investiture Ceremony on September 4<sup>th</sup> when students took oath at home in the presence of their parents who honored them with sash and badges, school flag and House flags handed over by the Chairman, Principal and Vice Principal, Hindi Diwas activities on September 14 which include Hindi Poem recitation competition for Std I to X, International Peace Day on September 22<sup>nd</sup> when students lighted candles and sang peace song, Digital Collage competition in connection with World Tourism Day on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, Gandhi Jayanthi activities as per instructions from CBSE , Students of VIII to XII participated in All Kerala Inter school Space Quiz competition on October 6 as part of World Space Week Competition conducted by VSSC, LPSE, ISRO IISU. Cooking Without Fire competition on World Food Day {October 16}, International Day of the Girl Child on October 11 when girls were asked to send their views on a few important topics, ZENIK Olympiad in October where 2 of our students were awarded prizes, Children's Day when students of 6 to 8 presented kitchen band and std I to V students dressed up and spoke as their favourite leaders, Malayalam recitation {December I}, National Maths Day on 22<sup>nd</sup> December when Math- O - Fun was attempted by students, Christmas with Family on 23<sup>rd</sup> December which included crib making and carol competitions, and on the same day students of std III TO X participated in Discovery School Super League Quiz, in the month of December students of Std VIII TO XII participated in National Scholarship Test {NST} by TIME, students were asked to write New Year Resolution on I January, Republic Day celebrations were conducted on January 26<sup>th</sup>.

Our students participated in almost all the activities and competitions conducted by the CBSE like Gandhi Jayanthi program where students planted saplings, dressed up like Gandhiji, created video on biography of Gandhiji, recited poems on Gandhiji, cleaned their homes and premises, created video on contributions of Gandhiji, wrote slogans, made charts, collages on quotes by Gandhiji, made placards, Story Telling, Expression Series on painting/cartoon/essay/poem writing, Pareeksha Pe Charcha.

PTA meetings were conducted online systematically for all the classes. The parents were given ample opportunities to express their views on various topics for the betterment of school functioning. Principal conducted special sessions on NEP for all the parents.

Two online SMC meetings were conducted wherein it was decided to give relaxation in the payment of fees, allowing parents to pay the fees monthly instead of quarterly. Decisions were also taken regarding timings of classes to be conducted online, uniform to be bought from any shop rather than compelling parents to get it from school.
